STEWARDS AND CLEANERS

STEWARDS:

Stewards are required at weekday Masses. This is a straight forward procedure and you would be required to arrive at Church 20 mins before Mass times

CLEANERS:

Cleaning needs to be undertaken after every Mass. If we have four people who could stay behind immediately after Mass on Tuesdays/Thursdays it would take around half an hour.

At the weekend Mass the cleaning is undertaken Sunday mornings **before** the 11.15 Mass (arrival at Church 10.00 a.m.) and on Monday 9.00 am or 2.00 p.m. Again if we have four people attending it would not take long.

We need to set up rotas for the two roles and the more people that can help the better.

Proposed Disposal of Hall, Land and Presbytery

Last year a decision was taken, in consultation with the Diocese, to dispose of the hall, land and presbytery adjacent to St Joseph's Church.

During the course of this year the Diocese's representatives have been negotiating with an interested major Social Housing provider.

This has been a sensitive and protracted process but it appears that we are now nearing a conclusion and formal agreement on the sale.

The Social Housing Provider has submitted a planning application to the Local Authority which means that the situation will become public knowledge.

Please be assured that the church of St Joseph will remain in use.

Plans for dealing with any consequences of the sale have been under active consideration for many months. Fuller details will be made known to Parishioners as soon as it is possible to do so without detriment to the sale.
