UPDATE ON PROPERTY MATTERS

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS AT ST JOSEPH'S

The sale to Great Places Housing Group was completed on 20th January 2021. They have approval to construct 18 apartments for rent. The process of demolition of the hall and presbytery has already begun.

Impact on St Joseph's Church

Worship - There will be no long term impact on the amenities for worship apart from the need to remove some of the benches at the rear of the nave.

Support Amenities - WC with disabled access; Multi-function meeting space; Kitchenette and serving hatch will be created in the narthex and former baptistery area.

Confessional Area - The façade will be retained but the rear space will be remodelled to provide a meeting room and new Emergency Exit.

Financial Impact - The Parish should receive circa £100k from the sale, but there will be substantial costs associated with the necessary structural alterations.

Work on the internal alterations and the long delayed external repairs should begin later in the Spring.

A statement of information has been prepared.

This includes the following illustrations:

the boundaries of the new development and its relationship to the church.

the proposed street elevations of the properties.

the alterations to the narthex, confessional area and link corridor.

POSSIBLE DEVELOPMENTS AT ST THOMAS OF CANTERBURY

The Parish Office is now housed in the room at the rear of the choir area. Active consideration is being given to identify how best to address current and future requirements through possible adaptations which do not encroach on to the body of the church. Information on any proposals will be published as soon as possible.
