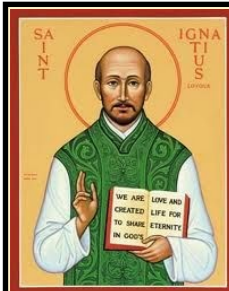

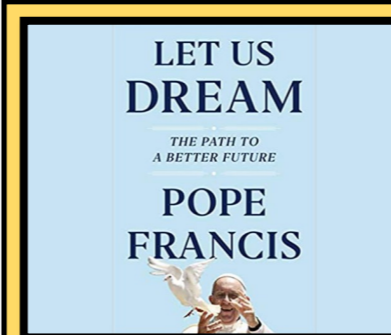

Miles that Matter

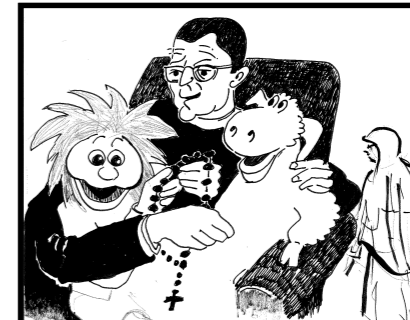
