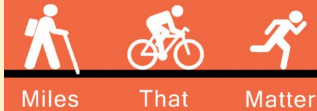

Online Retreat for Married Couples

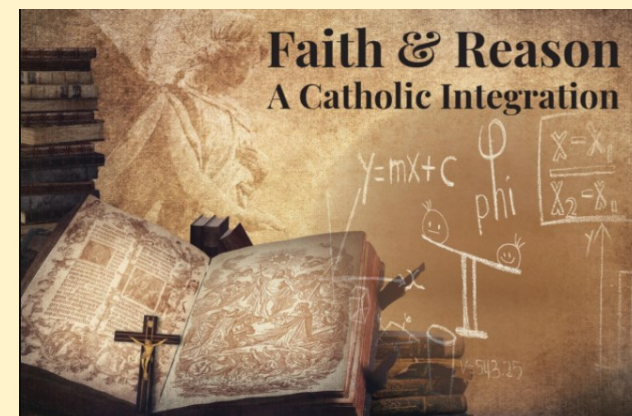

The course will go ahead assuming the lifting of Covid restrictions in July. Any bookings will be fully refunded in the event of an inevitable cancellation.

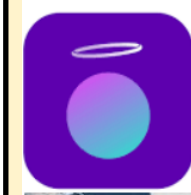
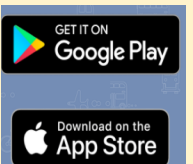

Two Online Prayer resources for you to look at



A lot of you will be familiar with this site already, but it is still worth a mention for those who may not have seen it. Jesuit inspired, it will help strengthen your prayer life with daily music and reflections, retreats and prayer tools. There is also an app (application) for your phone or tablet available from;

Hallow is a Catholic app for prayer and meditation that helps users deepen their relationship with God through audio-guided contemplative prayer. Some people refer to it as the "Headspace/Calm, for Catholics."



Hallow was started by a group of friends struggling to maintain their prayer lives amidst hectic personal and professional lives. The app offers 5-30 minute guided audio sessions using a variety of prayer types, including Christian Meditation, the Examen, Lectio Divina, the Rosary, and Spiritual Writing.
