All being well the Pilgrimage will hopefully be able to go ahead in November but we will have to wait until nearer the time to check any restrictions on travel to Europe. Details will be supplied when available nearer to the date of travel.

For all those who are booked on the Pilgrimage the balance payment is due no later than 13th September 2021 (please however check your individual invoices for confirmation of this date) and please arrange for payment to be made to Northern Star Travel in accordance with your invoice. If you have any queries regarding the travel arrangements or payment please contact Northern Star direct (tele 0161 773 2115)

If you are **not** arranging travel insurance via Northern Star **it is essential** that you have your insurance in place in good time and provide details to Northern Star as they require. Any queries regarding this aspect please contact Northern Star direct.

There will also be certain requirements for each party to enable travel to go ahead and, again these will be provided in due course. It will be essential that these requirements are in place before you will be able to travel.

As a general reminder please check that your Passport is in order and has sufficient time to run to enable you to travel to Europe. Also anyone holding (as an addition to travel insurance as mentioned above) the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) whether current or expired should check the Government website for information on use or renewal.
