Do you have an old phone or tablet lying in a drawer that you don't use? Jesuit Refugee Services UK are collecting smartphones and tablets to give to people experiencing the asylum and immigration system.



Phones and tablets should be in good working condition (able to make and receive calls and texts, a working screen and keyboard etc.) with no significant marks or scratches.

Phones and tablets must be wiped of all data and restored to factory settings or be accessible for a member of the team to erase all data. A working and compatible charger should be provided. Details of how to send your device can be found on Independent Catholic News
