

9.00a.m. at St. Joseph and 10.45 a.m. at St. Thomas of Canterbury during the week after Mass on Tuesdays at St. Thomas of Canterbury and after Mass on Wednesdays at St. Joseph

At the beginning of each Station the Leader will announce the Station and then say:

"We adore you O Christ and we praise you"

and the Response is:

"Because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world"



CAFOD FAMILY FAST DAY LENT APPEAL

Family Fast Day is Friday 11th. March, a day when we eat simply and give generously, remembering that there are many people around the world who need

our love and support. There are 200 million children in the world whose lives are at risk from malnutrition in countries like Sierra Leone, or as we are seeing now in Ukraine, families affected by conflict.

Donations to CAFOD this Lent will enable local experts to provide support to families in times of need or conflict.

You can donate in the Offertory Collection at Mass using a CAFOD envelope (or your own envelope marked "CAFOD"), or by visiting the CAFOD website cafod.org.uk/lent.

We have received an Email from CAFOD thanking St. Cuthbert's Parish for the donation of £1000 from the Christmas Collection. The money has gone to the Afghanistan Emergency Appeal.

CAFOD's local experts are providing emergency food and heating to the thousands of children, women and men who are on the brink of starvation in Afghanistan.
