Let us be inclusive, look after and reach out to each other the best way we can

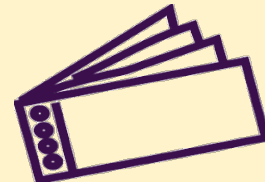
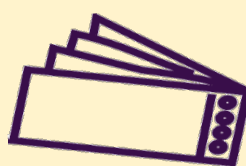
3. To bring other people to Jesus
