

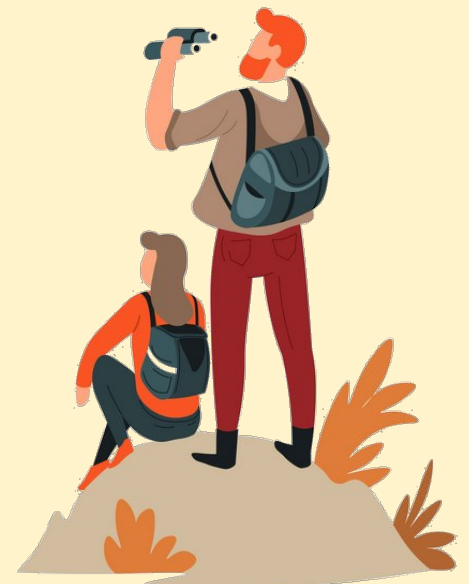


There will be a **Family Ramble** on
