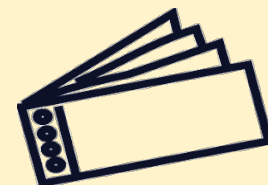

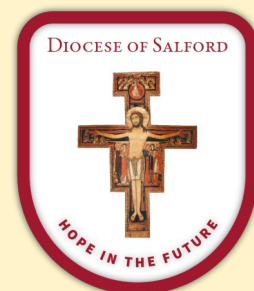
Formation Series: Gary Stephens – The Good News of Jesus Christ
