

We pray that we will grow daily in holiness and attract others to follow Jesus


Knights of St Columba

Piety Stall Open


There is a selection of first holy communion cards and gifts available in the west porch at St Thomas of Canterbury and at the back of St Joseph.

Additional cards, gifts and Mass cards are also available in the east porch of SToC.




Our charity for the Youth Mass on Saturday 9 July is


