Within the Diocese we are collaborating with other local SVP groups to provide a summer Holiday Camp for children in July 2023 and to offer support for prisoners on release. Around the country the Society also runs a number of major permanent projects – Community Support Centres, Holiday Camps for children, Furniture redistribution outlets and Food Banks. The SVP in England & Wales has a "twinning" relationship with SVP groups in India and also Sudan. Our own Parish group is twinned with Southern Sudan and we forward £150 each year as a small help for the SVP work in that troubled country.
