



A prayer of preparation for Lent Loving God,


I open the windows of my heart. I open the door of my soul. I welcome you here.



At the end of each Station ALL will say:

I love you Jesus, my love above all things.

I repent of ever having offended You.


Never allow me to offend You again.



# Stations of the Cross in house groups


We have been asking parishioners to provide a space in your homes for others to gather and pray the Stations of the Cross during Lent.






Is Lent your pilgrimage towards Easter?
