HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS

Following the decision of The Bishops'
Conference of England and Wales Bishop John
has advised that the reception of Communion
under both kinds may resume commencing
with The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy
Thursday.

After some discussion with the Parish Leadership Team, listening to the different opinions and concerns, Fr Chris has decided to wait for a future date to reintroduce the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds when it is felt that as a Parish we are ready for this to take place. We will undertake a process of consultation to help us consider the particular issues and concerns that people have.
