Hello, my name is Natalie, and I am currently in Year 11 studying for my GCSE's, an altar server for the Parish of St Cuthbert. I am very privileged to have been offered the opportunity to attend World Youth Day 2023 in Lisbon this summer and am hoping to raise funds to help me and other young people like me to get to this once in a lifetime celebration of faith event.

WYD is an international gathering bringing all the youth and young adults from around the world together in one place with the Holy Father, Pope Francis. It is a life-changing opportunity to gather, to journey together in pilgrimage, and to experience the universal Church through prayer, catechesis, celebration, and personal encounter.

WYD also seeks to promote peace, unity and fraternity among peoples and nations around the world. The Salesian Youth Movement will also be hosting a special day with the Salesian Rector Major (Fr. Ángel Fernández Artime SDB) and the Salesian Sisters' Mother General (Sr, Chiara Cazzuola FMA) in Lisbon, as well as a day of pilgrimage in Fatima.

I am thrilled to give you some information about the trip itself and the programme:

The programme consists of 8 days B&B in Fatima, flights, coach services for the whole 8 days, Registration package with WYD and Registration package with The Salesian Youth Movement

## Something to View = The Movie 'The Chosen' YouTube



It's an interesting approach to telling the story of the New Testament, and one that relies on a lot of creative license. The eight-part saga offers an invigorating look at Jesus Christ and his future disciples.

The first film production of Jesus that touches on the humanity of him and his disciples that doesn't take away his divine person and shows the merciful love of God. They cast believable characters. Staying true to the bible, Dallas Jenkins obviously does research and makes every effort to portray the characters with historical accuracy. Using artistic license, Jenkins carefully depicts characters and situations with great respect. Jonathan Roumie is exceptional as Jesus. This may not be to everyone's taste, but illustrates and colours, in realistic settings, the various episodes of Jesus' life, bringing it to life. You may not agree. But it is well worth viewing on your phone, tablet or TV.

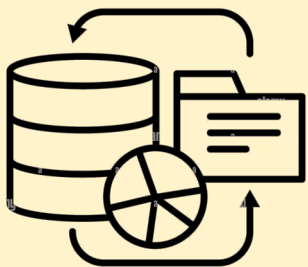
