Tea & Coffee will usually be served after the 9.30 am & 11.15 am Sunday Mass at St Thomas of Canterbury Church.

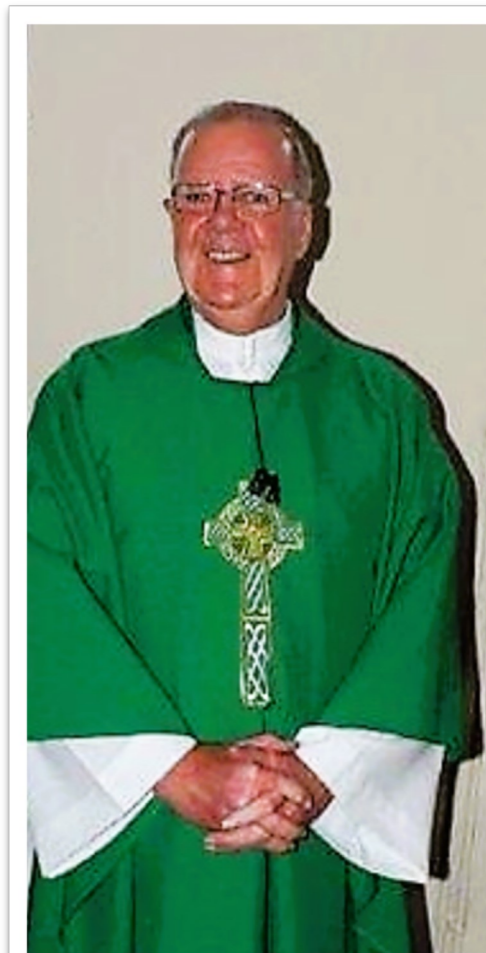
