Dear Parents, Carers & Families of Year 8 students

As part of the Diocesan Sacramental programme, Roman Catholic Children are eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation when they are in Year 8 of secondary school. This sacrament is an important milestone on their faith journey and we are delighted to work alongside or partner parishes to deliver the confirmation programme.

If you wish for your child to be confirmed they need to participate fully in the programme which runs through the year with some sessions taking place at Thornleigh and others in the parish. The new Salford Diocese E-Newsletter is out now with many items of news and interest. Included in these;


World Youth Day
