
Offertory Envelopes – Gift Aid / Please collect from the back of the church





The Big Listen Stage has been completed.

Thanks to all the parishioners who took part in the meetings held in our two churches and to all those who responded to the questionnaires distributed at weekend masses. Your responses have been summarised and submitted to the Diocesan office. These will be added to those from other parishes and analysed to produce 'Emerging Themes' which will be published shortly.

A summary of our parish responses are :-

Where in your everyday life do you experience love, hope, or joy?

Love and joy through family and friends (x12) The church and parish community(x6) Hope that God sustains us through difficult times (x2) Joy in God's Creation, Music, Arts and the natural environment (x3)

What concerns or worries make it hard to live a life of faith and hope?

Conflicts, wars, inhumanity, (x10) Loss of faith in children and young people due to effects of contemporary society (x3) Global warming and future generations (x2) Poverty and mental health issues increasing (x2) Past record of the church's failings still not apologised for.

What do you sense is the role of the Catholic Church in the world today?

Act as a unifying force, acceptance of all, inclusivity, access to marginalised (x10) Uphold and spread Gospel values and the good news of redemption/salvation (x4) To promote peace (x3) To speak for those who no-one will listen to.

Having reflected on these things, what do you sense God is asking of the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Salford at this time?

To find ways of increasing the involvement of young people (x6)To look after the vulnerable, destitute and deprived (x3)Improve communication between clergy and laity and increase lay involvement (x5)To open more social activities - youth clubs, mother and baby units, day centres etc (x3)To take steps to look after the planet (x3)Emphasise the importance of prayer and catechesis.
